A brief primer on global warming

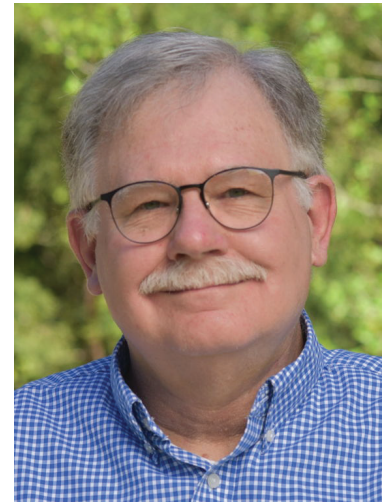
Vince Cronin, Geoscientist and NPSOT Tyler Chapter Member
